

POP Uniform FAQs

▪ General

- How should we dispose of unusable uniform items that will no longer be relevant? [Our Christian Service Coordinator is working to see if there is an opportunity for them to be used by our sister parish in Honduras. Stay tuned!](#)
- Do all shirts need to be embroidered or can people continue to wear the plain versions with no logo next year? [Shirts should be embroidered with the POP logo. It is important that outward facing tops have our logo on them.](#)
- Can students continue to wear the quarter zip navy pullovers they already have? [Yes](#)
- Can students continue to wear their navy POP cardigans/v-neck sweaters they already have? [Yes](#)
- Can girls continue to wear their navy POP vests (there are no vest options on the new site for girls)? [Yes](#)

▪ CLC

- Are boys only allowed to wear the navy polo shirts next year, or are they still allowed to wear red like the older grades? [Navy only](#)
- Do polo shirts have to be embroidered and official from Tommy Hilfiger, or can we still buy plain polos from other retailers? [Polos must be embroidered with the POP logo.](#)
- Can girls continue to wear the old white Peter Pan shirts with the red piping next year? [No, CLC girls will need to wear the new all-white interlock peter pan shirts from Tommy Hilfiger.](#)
- Can you confirm that the CURRENT red plaid being worn in the CLC will NOT be accepted next year? [This is correct. The CLC plaid will change. However, the current CLC plaid will be worn by girls in next year's K-2 learning community. So, if you have a current 4k or 5k girl, they may continue to wear the current style jumpers in grades K-2 if you wish.](#)

▪ K – 2nd

- Can you confirm that CURRENT style jumpers and/or skirts/skortis will be able to continue to be worn? [Yes. The current CLC-5th grade plaid will be worn by girls in next year's K-2 learning community. So, next year, K-2 girls may continue to wear the current style jumpers and skirts in grades K-2 if you wish.](#)
- Can girls continue to wear the old white Peter Pan shirts with the red piping next year (new piping is navy)? [Yes, the red or blue piping will satisfy uniform requirements for K-2 girls next year.](#)

- **3rd – 5th**
 - Can girls continue to wear the white oxford shirts they have without the embroidered logo, or is the logo required? **It is important that outward facing tops have our logo on them.**

- **6th – 8th**
 - If my daughter is going into 8th grade and only has one more year left at POP, is she able to wear her existing plaid skirt? **Unfortunately, girls in grades 6-8 will not be able to wear our current 6-8 plaid next year. They are still able to wear white oxfords and blue quarter zips though.**
 - If my son is going into 8th grade and only has one more year left at POP, is he able to wear his existing striped oxford shirt? **Unfortunately, boys in grades 6-8 will not be able to wear our current 6-8 striped oxford shirts next year. They are still able to wear their blue quarter zips though.**
